Sequoia National Park is a national park in the southern Sierra Nevada, east of Visalia, California, in the United States. The word "Sequoia" means "Big Tree" in the language of Old Native Americans.

There are two different types of sequoia trees in this Park: the "redwood sequoia" and the "giant sequoia". The "redwood sequoia" is taller than the "giant sequoia". It can reach 120 m. high.

In this park, you can see a unique tree: it's a Giant Sequoia called "General Sherman". It's the oldest living thing in the world. It's about 3,500 years old. The park is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Occasionally, some parts of the park might be closed, if the weather is very bad.

Ticket prices:

- \$20 for a single person;
- \$35 for a vehicle pass which includes everyone travelling in the vehicle;
- \$200 for a bus with more than 26 people.

All entrance tickets are valid for 7 days.
